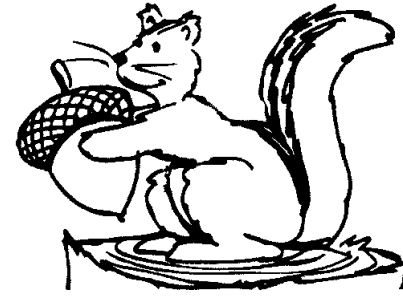

OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. Tournament official's decisions will be final.
2. Scoring will be on total weight in pounds and tenths of pounds. A 2/10 pound penalty will be deducted from the total weight for each dead fish. All live bass will be released.
3. 1lb penalty for each short fish brought in to weigh in.
4. Bass must meet lake limits. Bass will be measured following I. D.N.R. standards i.e., mouth shut, nose to board, tail pinched. A 5 fish limit per team in effect.
5. Check in will be at the boat ramp. Weigh in will be at the Rotary Park pavilion south of the parking lot.
6. Each team must be checked in by 6:00 a.m. Pre-tournament meeting will be at 6:15 a.m.
7. Only artificial baits allowed....pork rinds permitted, no trolling.
8. Bait casting, spin cast, spinning, flipping and fly-casting gear only.
9. No alcoholic beverages allowed in boats during tournaments.
10. Except for an emergency, team members must remain in the boat at all times.
11. Life jackets must be worn anytime gas engine is running.
12. Contestants who are not in the official check in area at the appointed time will be penalized 1 lb. per minute, including any weight towards big bass. Any team more than 10 minutes late will be disqualified.
13. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any team or contestant.
14. All boats must meet State of Illinois and Coast Guard regulations and be equipped with aerated live wells or aerated coolers. No stringers or wire baskets.
15. Sportsmanship: All contestants are expected to follow the highest standards of sportsmanship, safety and conservation. Failing to do so will result in disqualification and forfeiture of any entry fees.
16. Percentage of cash awards for 2nd – 10th place will be determined by number of teams entering tournament.
17. The City of Olney is not responsible or liable for injuries, accidents, losses, or unlawful acts committed by or towards any contestant.
18. Entry deadline is Sept. 4, 2010 at 6:00 a.m. at the boat ramp.
19. Any team with fish to be weighed in must be in line before 3:00 p.m.
20. All boats must have a valid City of Olney boat license. For more information visit www.ci.olney.il.us
21. Winning team will be subject to a polygraph test.
