Agenda #1 “CALL TO ORDER” The meeting of the Parks and Recreation Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 300 S. Whittle Ave., Olney, Illinois with Morgan Henton presiding.

Agenda #2 “ROLL CALL” The following Parks and Recreation members were present: All members were present. Morgan Henton, Connie Buss, Lisa Bruner, Jason Doris, Brandy Shouse, Luke Fairless, and Mallory Fairless.

Agenda #3 “APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MEETING ON FEBRUARY 15, 2017”

Luke Fairless moved to approve the previous month’s meeting and seconded by Jason Doris. A majority affirmative voice vote was received.

Agenda #4 “PUBLIC COMMENTS/PRESENTATIONS” No one from the public gave any comments.

Agenda #5A Mayor Mark Lambird was not in attendance.

Agenda #5B A group of students from the JILG program at the high school with a member of the Clay County Health Department presented material encouraging the City to make Musgrove Park tobacco free. They presented information from an online survey that asked the public’s opinion on smoking in the parks which showed 67% agreed that the parks should be tobacco free. They also presented an example resolution which we amended slightly and approved to recommend it to the city council for adoption. The Clay County Health department has in their budget to give the city three 18"X24" signs which will display the No Smoking.

Agenda #5C The Board discussed different designs for the East Fork Lake trails. Discussions included verbiage on the sign, size of signage, as well as design. After many variations were discussed no official action was taken.

Agenda #5D Lisa Bruner gave updates on the Adopt-A-Bed program. Several new businesses were added to the program while also losing a few. Several businesses gave feedback on they didn't think the beds were being watered enough with new flowers added. Connie Buss continues to work with Park Supervisor Frank Bradley.

Agenda #5E Morgan Henton retained Chairman and Luke Fairless was elected as Vice Chair.

Some discussion on the addition of camping spots in the City Park but no official action taken.
