A. Pickleball

1. Motion made by John McLaughlin that the Park and Recreation Board recommend the conversion of one (1) City tennis court into four (4) Pickleball courts on a temporary basis until permanent Pickleball courts are built be accepted by City Council as presented. Seconded by Brandy Shouse. Unanimous vote followed.

B. Comprehensive Plan

1. Information reported from Councilman John McLaughlin that walkways and boat slips at East Fork Lake have been approved by the City Council to be replaced.

Motion made by Drew Holdren to double the size of the basketball courts at Musgrove Park. Seconded by Connie Buss and unanimous vote followed.

Motion made by Connie Buss to add lighting to the Soccer Field at Musgrove Park. Seconded by Drew Holdren. Unanimous vote followed.

Motion made by Drew Holdren to pave and stripe all parking lots at Musgrove Park, seconded by Brandy Shouse, and unanimous vote followed.

Motion made by John McLaughlin to recommend adding 58 parking spaces by the Babe Ruth Field at Musgrove Park is accepted by the City Council as presented. Seconded by Drew Holdren. Unanimous vote followed.

Open Discussion:


1. Concessions at Musgrove Park:
